- 1. Meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

A copy of this report will be shared with all committee members to review so we can decide how to proceed. Jacque will send a letter of thanks to Mike Williams acknowledging his timely response to our complaint.

7. Re-opened projects:

a) Fry's Grocery store at Rural & Southern---Jose and Janie will complete a Development Services complaint form for approval by Commission, then submit to Development Services.

- b) Broadway Apartments---It was discussed that HUD may wield more power to handle the complaints. Karl mentioned that this project's issues are more safety-related, especially with respect to lighting. Funding by grant money has already been explored and is not available. The first step should be to determine if this property is HUD funded. Dan will bring aerial photos to the next meeting.
