- Sharon Doyle expressed concerns over KDA and committee's time constraints. A tour of the Phoenix side of Papago Park would be nice if it does not interfere with the duties of the Rio Salado/Papago Park Ad Hoc Committee.
- Sharon Doyle was concerned that the Design Principles Charette was not open to input from the community. The committee has a responsibility of voicing their opinion.
- The Design Principles Charette was designed for directors of various municipalities to come together and give their perspective about the park. By no means was in intended to set the tone for future public meetings. The upcoming public workshops will give the public an opportunity to give their ideas.
- The workshops will take place April 29, 2009, June 15, 2009 and August 20, 2009.

- Information about the dates of the public workshops will be printed on fliers and sent out in water bills and a mayoral public address will air on various local stations.
- Committee members would like Papago Park to have cultural component and educational tools for the public. Possibly incorporating interactive kiosks with information about the parks history or a self-guided tour.
- Shane Anton would like the park defined and work with what we have.
- Shawn Wagner would like to know what the public's perception is and build to that standard.
- Define locations and once people are drawn to the attraction, they will realize there is more to Papago Park.
- Shane Anton asked how we change the public's perception of viewing the park as a whole.
- Shawn Wagner will forward the committee information about the upcoming public workshops and organize tour of the Phoenix portion of Papago Park.
