

**Human Relations Commission  
Subcommittee on SB 1070  
Meeting Minutes, May 27, 2010**

**Tempe City Hall, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room

In attendance: Colleen Byron, Rosa Inchausti, Ginny Belousek

1. Meeting was called to order at 4 p.m.
2. There were no members from the public present for comments.
3. Commissioner Byron began by stating that there are many forums and marches being planned around SB 1070, however she feels that the HB 2281 on Ethnic Studies in the public schools is potentially more problematic. It was decided to plan the upcoming community forum around both SB 1070 and HB 2281, but to strongly emphasize the latter.

The committee discussed the previous Community Forum that was held a few years ago on Day Labor issues. It was decided to mirror the format of that forum, which was a panel discussion. Potential panelists mentioned were: the three school superintendants, a representative from the City Attorney's office, Ed Ableser, and David Shapira. The dates being considered for the forum are either June 29 or July 13, and staff will follow up on securing the Museum Community Room as the venue. The topic for the forum will be, "Legal Challenges of HB 2281 and SB 1070". The purpose of the community forum is purely informational, and no follow-up action is necessary. The best outcome is for people to be provided with the resources they need to have a rational and informed opinion.

Discussion then focused on the upcoming HRC meeting, which will be a study session for the commission on both bills. It was decided to have Commissioner Byron lead the study session, as she is the chair of the subcommittee. Copies of SB 1070 will be mailed out in advance to the commissioners. Additionally, Rosa will e-mail the commissioners with the following message, "the subcommittee has decided that the upcoming HRC meeting will be a study session in preparation for the community forum, and will focus on the legal implications of SB 1070 and HB 2281. The bill will be included in the HRC packets. Commissioner Byron has asked that the commissioners please review the texts and formulate/submit questions to Rosa for the study session."
