Agenda 2 - Monthly Activity Reports for October and January 7, 2008

Increasingly, these formats are being made available as digital downloads from the Library's web site. The Library program attendance has increased in the last month.

#### Agenda 3 - Library Remodel Update

Teri informed the Board that a "Request for Qualifications" for architects was issued in early December and eight architectural firms responded. The proposals were evaluated by Teri, Tom Canasi, and Key members of the City's Engineering Division. Based upon that evaluation, four firms were selected to make a presentation on February 11<sup>th</sup> to the group, followed by a question and answer session. It is hope that a firm will be selected and presented for City Council approval in March.

Ira King asked about the status of the Tilted Landscape art piece in front of the Library. Teri responded that the Cultural Services Division is working with the artist to repair and modify the work.

# Agenda 4 - Friends of the Tempe Public Library Report

The Friends generated over \$3,900.00 in book sales from the Book Corner in December.

The Friends continue to increase membership. As of today, there are 294 members.

The Friends placed signage throughout the Library to promote activities sponsored by the Friends.

The Friends continue to support Library Youth Programs. The Teen Spot opened on 1/9/08 with a generous furniture donation from IKEA.

The Friends will have their Spring Book Sale on April 12, 2008. From 9 am to 10 am, the sale is open to members only. Memberships may be purchased at the door. The sale will be open to the general public from 10 am to 2 pm.
